Should a vendor at any time occupy the premises in a manner which is hazardous or offensive to the public or other vendors, upon request of the Market Manager, vendor shall immediately cease such offending conduct. Failure to immediately conform as requested shall be cause to revoke this Agreement.

The vendor understands that the location of the Market may change if permission for using the premises is withdrawn at any time. The undersigned agrees not to hold the Market or the City of John Day liable for any loss or damage claimed should the market location change for any reason.
